# NABANY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

**Scholarship Application and Instructions**

Since inception, the National Association of Black Accountants, Inc. (NABA) has provided thousands in scholarship funds to deserving students, through the generous contributions of individuals, groups, and organizations that share NABA's desire to break through the economic barrier minorities often experience.

Scholarship applications will be accepted until **May 8, 2009** (fax receipt deadline).

These scholarships will be presented to awarded students at the **NABANY Scholarship & Awards Dinner on June 4, 2009**. **Recipients are required to attend**. The actual cash awards will be made at a later date after receipt of proof of enrollment for the period(s) covered by the award (Fall 2009 and Spring 2010).

**Applicants Must:**

1. Be an **ACTIVE** NABANY student member, whose membership dues have been received by NABA's National Office no later than **December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2008**. **Special Note:** Regardless of the circumstances, once becoming a professional member, you are not permitted to return to student status. Graduate students must have entered graduate school immediately after receiving their undergraduate degree.
  2. Be currently enrolled at a United States college or university as a full-time student (12 semester hours or equivalent), and be an **undergraduate** freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior not scheduled to graduate until Fall 09 or later. Additionally you must be an accounting, finance, or business major **or** be a full-time **graduate** candidate or student (9 semester hours or equivalent) enrolled or accepted into a master's-level business program. **Current high school students are not eligible.**

4. Scholarships may have other specific criteria that are not identified on this application.

**Please submit the following:**

- A completed **NABANY Scholarship Application**. Please type or clearly print your responses, including "N/A" for items that are not applicable to you. The application **MUST** be completed in its entirety, submitted with the items listed below.
- A current **Academic Transcript (through Fall 08)**. Unofficial transcripts will be accepted.
- All Scholarship winners must present an official transcript once you have been notified that you are a recipient. You must request that your University's registrar forward the transcript directly to you or the NABA NY P. O. Box. We will not accept student copies or other unofficial transcripts for verification purposes. *Most schools assess a nominal service charge to send official transcripts.*
- A clear copy of Student/Permanent Resident Visa (only if applicant **IS NOT** a United States citizen).
- A Current **Resume**.

- **A Personal Biography of 500 words or less.** Your biography should specifically discuss your career objectives; leadership abilities, community activities, and **your involvement in NABANY** (include any offices held, exceptional achievements, and/or special recognitions and awards).
  - If you are a student who has demonstrated the character to persevere by overcoming a personal, family, or financial hardship, please include an **additional** statement of 500 words or less describing the circumstances and how the obstacles were overcome.

Awards are made for the following academic year. Awards will be sent directly to the student. *Awardees may qualify for renewals as long as the student continues to make satisfactory progress toward completion of their degree requirements, but she/he must re-apply each year.*

5. I understand that if completion of my studies is planned for the middle of the academic year (i.e., a December graduate), I will receive 50% of the scholarship award.
